TackleShare Program Overview

The TackleShare Program, launched in 1998, is a long-running initiative of the Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters (OFAH). With the support of the official lead sponsor, Ontario Power Generation (OPG), TackleShare is able to break down barriers that prevent new or novice anglers from taking the initiative to fish Ontario's thousands of lakes and rivers.

The TackleShare Program is the only one of its kind in Canada that provides equipment to children who may not otherwise have the opportunity to experience the excitement of fishing -- and it is completely free. Thanks to TackleShare, money or accessibility to angling equipment is no longer a barrier. More children and novice anglers are given the opportunity to experience fishing, and in turn, understand the importance of conservation and water safety.

TackleShare Loaner Sites

Since the launch of the program, over 140 loaner sites have been established across the province, allowing thousands of new anglers to become involved in recreational fishing. These loaner sites include Ontario Parks, public libraries, conservation areas, and other community organizations. Participating anglers simply sign out a rod and reel, as well as an assortment of tackle in the same way that they would borrow library materials.

To operate as a loaner site you must:

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| <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Be within a reasonable distance to a fishable shoreline;2. Keep the fishing equipment tidy and readily available for all participants;3. Display the following:<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. current fishing regulations for participants to read;b. TackleShare brochures; andc. TackleShare posters.4. Complete a "sign-out form" every time fishing equipment is borrowed; | <ol style="list-style-type: none">5. Promote TackleShare within your community whenever possible via:<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. social media;b. local news releases;c. local radio and tvd. internal newsletters/tabloids/websites;e. cross promote TackleShare with other community events.6. Submit an online summary by September 15 each year;7. Mail in all "sign-out forms" to OFAH by October 1. |
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In return, TackleShare will provide each loaner site with the following:

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ *A minimum of four rod and reel combos;➤ *A minimum of four fully stocked tackle boxes;➤ Posters and brochures;➤ Window decal; | <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Sign-out forms;➤ TackleShare stickers;➤ Young Angler Licences; and➤ Recognition of your loaner site at www.tackleshare.com. |
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* More fishing equipment may be made available upon request and availability.
