


COMMON "BASS" of ONTARIO

How to identify Rock Bass, Smallmouth Bass and Largemouth Bass



Although "bass" is used in it's common name, the Rock Bass is more often associated with panfish than the Largemouth Bass and Smallmouth Bass seen below.





SMALLMOUTH BASS

Wide dark horizontal stripe extending the length of the body

LARGEMOUTH BASS

FISHING TIPS:

These fish are often aggressive and sought after by anglers because they put up a good fight when hooked. They'll strike a variety of presentations including live bait (worms, crayfish, leeches or minnows) and artificial lures (spinners, crankbaits and plastics).
